

Validation of self-reported medication use by claims data



STUDY QUESTION


- -How valid is self-reported medication use?
- -What are the individual factors affecting the validity?

Self-reported questionnaires are widely employed in epidemiologic studies, but their validity has not been sufficiently assessed. Claims data could be helpful to capture true medication users.



1,128 men + 1,344 women (37-78 years old) from the Tsuruoka Metabolomics Cohort Study

Validity of self-reported medication use





Self-reported questionnaires was a valid measure to capture regular medication users.

Sex, education and smoking status influenced discordance in those with dyslipidemia.
